BAAP Vision Statement:

To lower the rate of recidivism one ex-offender at a time and to create a safer community with fewer crimes and fewer victims.

BAAP Mission Statement:

To provide the necessary programs, services and support to prevent the "revolving door" in our jails and prisons, reduce crime in our community while also preventing homelessness, providing basic needs, education, training and the support to become successful, contributing members of the community. Based on following Jesus, our focus is on the healing of family relationships, the caring for children and the overall well-being of those living in the greater Baltimore, Maryland area.

PARTNER FOR SUCCESS

Partner for Success is our faith-based mentoring program designed specifically to help men and women who were incarcerated and released recently make a smooth transition back into society. This program requires a minimum commitment of six months. The participant is matched with a mentor and a faith community that works with the participant to establish a plan of action for reentry back into the community and a plan of action for their future.

Partner for Success focuses on immediate and longer term goals than Project Makeover. Statistics show that successful completion of a mentoring program, such as **Partner for Success**, correlates to a higher success rate for staying out of jail or prison.
