**Outreach options\* to volunteer monthly or weekly (including hands-on help):**#8 On the second Monday of each month, Christ Episcopal Church provides a hot midday meal at Grassroots' Day Resource Center (DRC) and drops off dinner for 70 residents of the Emergency Shelter. Participants can prepare a dish to be handed off at church, provide grocery items such as milk and fruit, and/or serve homeless guests in person. Our DRC online signup form describes the procedure. Drop-off time is 12:45 p.m. in the Christ Church parking lot near Old Brick. In-person volunteers for the team of at least four people depart at 1 p.m. to carpool to 10390 Guilford Rd., Jessup. **#4** Columbia Community Care (CCC) calls for volunteers who make home deliveries in several roles including translator, help on Saturday mornings at three walk-in distribution sites, and sorter at a pantry shared with FISH of Howard County.
